Tulloch 2006 Pokolbin Dry Red Shiraz

MY taste buds revel in the return of Tulloch reds like this one to the standards of old. This is made from grapes grown on the great Tallawanta and Stevens vineyards. It would go well with rabbit goujons with roasted garlic mayonnaise, pork sirloin with sauteed red cabbage and apple or slow-cooked shoulder of lamb. It is purple-hued and has aromas of blackberries and white pepper. Intense, smooth plum flavour shows on the front of the palate and briar, peppermint chocolate and licorice fruit characters combine with lightly applied vanillin oak. Smooth earthy tannins feature at the finish.
