Good old Tulloch! A proud name experiencing something of a resurgence (unlike Lindemans) much like the Hunter Valley has had recently, with a string of good red vintages since 2003 (don't mention 2008 though).

A pretty young thing (or a "PYT" as Michael Jackson might say...and where did that come from!) with some cinnamon spicy vanilla oak over fresh berry and cherry fruit. Medium bodied with a light Hunter red fruited earthiness married to equally light but dry grippy tannin - tight and backwards at present but with a good breathing much improved. Really good wine but drink the standard release whilst waiting for this to come round.
